Ribbon is now on the table. Use it if you wish to indicate to others you would prefer not to have dogs visiting your dog.

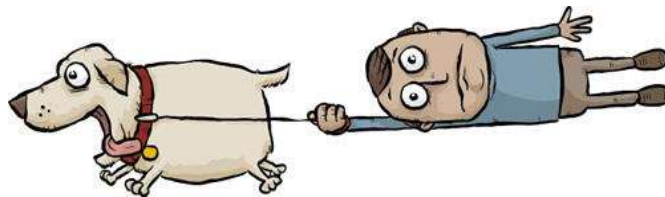
### RENTAL:

## **Joanne Summers reported on : PROPOSED NEW CLASSES**

STEP OUT - a program for 12 to 15 year old handlers and their dogs.

An exciting new Dog Obedience Training Course for 12 to 15 year olds who are interested in learning about the Sport of Dog Obedience, Rally, and basic agility exercises. Games to better your dogs recall, walking on a leash, attention, good manners and more will be covered. The emphasis is on giving the young handler the skills desired for developing a great family pet .

6 weeks – 1 hour per week. Limit – 6 Dog/Handler Teams

Limit – 6 Dog/Handler Teams

Dogs should be 6 months or older.

Cost: \$100.00

### **MANNERS I/CANINE GOOD CITIZEN PROGRAM**

This course is for those who have completed a basic beginner course and need to continue working on the basics of good manners. This course fine-tunes your dog's good manners and attention skills as well as further improves your training skills which were introduced in a basic Beginner Obedience Class.

Dogs will be schooled on how the exercises that are part of The Canine Good Citizen Test.

The Canine Good Citizen Test is included as part of the Manners I Course

Prerequisite for this class is a Basic Beginner Class

7 Weeks – 1 hour per week

Cost- \$140.0

### **AKC STAR PUPPY PROGRAM**

This is a positive, educational, and fun experience for dogs up to the age of one year. The components of the course are Socialization, Training, Activity, and handlers learning Responsible dog ownership. Puppies are well socialized and learn the skills that are the basics for future training. The S.T.A.R.

Puppy Test is offered with this course. Only an AKC Canine Good Citizen approved evaluator can be an Instructor for this class.

7 weeks – 1 hour per week

Cost - \$140.0

**AKC COMMUNITY CANINE:** In this course you will be extending your dog's knowledge of the CGC exercises. You will be working in a natural setting such as a park or near obedience training classes

Prerequisite is a CGC. Test will be offered at the end of the course

6 weeks – 1 hour per week

Cost -\$130.00

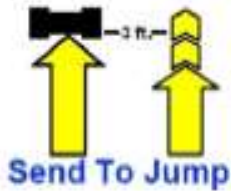

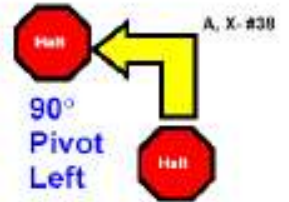
