Note: there will be no full courses. We will be working on learning the proper footwork and polishing our techniques. Plenty of tips & tricks to make Rally fun for you and your dog.


Requirements: Handler and dog must have completed an ADTC rally class or rally experience. An understanding of the rally exercises at their level is required.


he Whippets have been busy in the Rally ring and have a couple of new titles!
