A TRIBUTE TO A GREAT DOG**

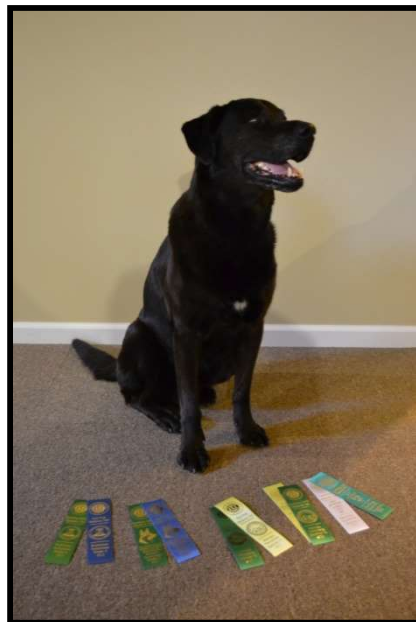
It is with great sadness as well disappointment that Emmett is retiring from AKC Competitive Obedience. On May 25, he broke his right hind leg while running along our fence after a boy who was skateboarding by the house. It was determined by the veterinarians at both Valley Central and Quakertown Veterinary Clinic that the break was due to bone cancer in that leg. In order to save his life and to relieve his pain, his leg was amputated, thus ending his AKC Obedience career.

Emmett was my Novice A dog who is my friend and partner on this journey. When we started I could have never imagined how far we were able to go. He finished all his titles with placements, a lot of them firsts. Utility was a lot harder but we did place in all of his title qualifications but one and that was in Utility B. After he finished his Utility Dog title in September of 2013 and his Versatility Dog title in November, 2013, he was on a roll!!! We picked up four UDX legs in four straight trials. Not only that but we also had 45 Obedience Master Points and 10 OTCH points. I knew we would never complete those two titles but it is a thrill to know that he has those points to his name. There was a good possibility we might have earned the UDX but now that is not to be. Our time to finish that ran out on May 25.

At this point, we are planning on doing our best to beat this cancer. But the important thing is that Emmett has a great retirement which he so deserves. I know he will miss the training and all the matches and trials, as well as all the friends we have made over the years. Once he is well, we may continue training a bit, just to keep him in shape, active and healthy. He may compete in the Companion Dog Sports Program competitions but that is down the road for now. He will be going for walks with some of his friends around the Park and maybe even sit in for some stays if he would like to!!! It has been an amazing journey for a dog who was once on death row in a Tennessee shelter!!!

Emmett and I also want to thank our training partners, both human and canine, who helped us over all these years. We could have not done it without you. THANK YOU ALL SO MUCH!! In addition I would also like to thank everyone who have kept Emmett and I, but especially Emmett in their thoughts and prayers and sent cards. It has been so heartwarming to know that we have such wonderful members who care. THANK YOU ALL!!!

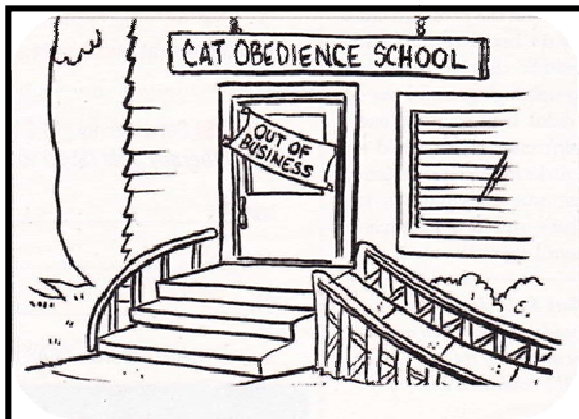
