Etta owned by Berdell Koch completed her CDSP Novice Championship at Let's Speak Dog

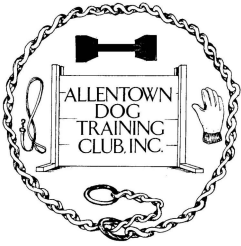
