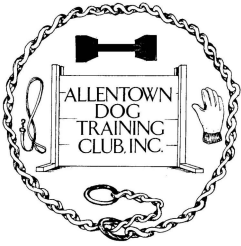


Trips owned by Debra Petrusjanz completed his UKC Utility Title in his first 3 trials with 2 first places and 1 second place He then went H in T from the Open B class
