ALLENTOWN DOG TRAINING CLUB

Training Director Report March 10, 2021

Wednesday Club training and Thursday Novice – new sessions started March 10th and 11th. Open has 15 registered and this class has been divided into 2 classes to accommodate everyone. Show Ready novice has 10, Advanced Beginner 7, Beginner Utility 2, Thursday day novice has 8. Its great to see members training once again.

Most kennel club shows are cancelled due to the limits on gatherings. Obedience clubs are offering shows once again. If you plan on entering obedience shows, please remember you must enter day of opening or you may get blocked out. Some shows are filling within hours of opening date.

Linda's next rally class is Novice. If you wish to sign up, contact Linda.

Anna's current open and utility sessions end March 18th. New sessions start March 25th. To sign up, please contact Anna.

Terry's puppy class will end March 18th and the new session starts March 25th 5 to 5:45pm.

AKC Judges' New Post.

Effective April 1st a Fix N Go pilot program will begin. This program will run for 1 year. Handler may choose to use a Fix n Go when the dog's performance does not meet the handler's expectation, the handler may use the fix n go option once. This allows the exhibitor to immedieately reattempt a single individual exercise, then leave the ring. It is the handler's responsibility to tell the judge they are choosing to fix n go. They can choose to reattempt the whole exercise or part of the exercise. They may not touch the dog, but can use verbal encouragement, including additional

commands and praise and/or approach the dog in a friendly/positive manner without touching the dog.

Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections will not be tolerated. If there is any determination of harshness by the judge, the handler will be immediately released from the ring.

If the handler chooses to use the fix n go, but does not tell the judge, just starts it by themselves, then the handler is subject to being released from the ring for training in the ring.

If jumps need to be reset, they will be reset at the original height.

I have received a new post from the AKC regarding Proper Examination Approach. It reminds judges must approach the dog from the front, at a slight angle. Never block dog's vision from seeing its handler. Never approach the dog from the side.

Banquet: The Board voted to cancel the 2021 banquet due to covid regulations on limits of social gatherings.

2021 ADTC Obedience and Rally Trial Report

- The 2021 Allentown Dog Training Club Obedience and Rally trials will be held indoors at Macungie Memorial Park.
- There will be one ring Friday, May 21 and one ring Saturday, May 22.
- Regular classes only will be offered and class sizes will be limited.
- Entries will be taken by <u>ShowEntries.info</u>. The Premium List can be found on that website, or you can follow the link on the ADTC website Home Page.
- 1st Entry \$32, 2nd Entry of same dog \$28
- The Rally trial will be on Friday morning, judged by Diane Stout.
- The BN/Novice A/B classes will be held on Friday afternoon, judged by Linda Morris.
- The Open A/B classes will be Saturday morning, judged by Linda Morris.
- The Utility A/B classes will be Saturday afternoon, judged by Elizabeth Chase.
- There will be no crating in the building and a minimal number of exhibitors will be allowed in the building at any given time. Exhibitors will need to work from their vehicles and wait outside until they are called into the building.
- Exhibitors will have to provide their own food/beverages and eat outside the building. There are multiple places to eat within walking distance of the Trial location.
- Previous donations to the Trophy Fund will be honored at these trials and our 2022 trials. Regular class ribbons/rosettes, leashes and toys from our cancelled 2020 trial will be utilized at this trial.
